The University of the State of New York Regents Research Fund received a grant to strengthen the teaching of elementary mathematics in New York State. The Regents Research Fund is seeking a Mathematics Education Consultant to create a comprehensive set briefs on effective, evidence ased practices for teaching mathematics in the elementary grades and give presentations on the content of the briefs. The audience for the briefs is New York State-1/2 educators, teacher preparation program candidates and faculty, and other stakeholders.

This position is primarily remote and requires virtual meetings. While the development of the briefs is remote, there will be occasional travel to Albany and to model partnership site(s) between an institution of higher education (IHE) and an elementary school or network of elementary schools (to be determined), which would be paid by the funds awarded. This is a temporary position that ends on or before June 30, 2025.

The candidate must have a deep understanding efresearch and evidence on effective practices for teaching mathematics and preparing new educators to implement those evidenced practices. The major activities for this position include, but are not limited to:

- x Writing up to five briefs on effective, evidencebased practices for teaching mathematics in the elementary grades on a variety of topics, such as using duglity instructional materials, providing culturally and linguistically responsive supports, employing effective assessment tooks; garging in performancebased learning and assessment.
- x Delivering presentations, including professional learning webinars, on the content of the briefs to K

- x Strong written and oral communication skills
- x Experience working in or with 1/2 schools

COMPENSATION:

Up to \$30,000, commensurate with the number of briefs and presentations. Applicants may be an individual or a team of two or more individuals.
