All children who are referred for special education services

(NYCDOE) are required to collect and submit referral and evaluation data to the New York State Education Department. Districts report: the date of referral, date of written parent consent for an initial evaluation, date of the committee on preschool special education meeting to determine eligibility and date the individualized education program (IEP) is implemented. For children whose eligibility determination was not made or whose IEPs were not implemented by their third birthday or in compliance with State requirements, the reasons for the delay are collected. The Statewide data sample is based on the referral of children from Part C received between July 1 and June 30 and the status of the IEP implementation as of August 31.
