Dear Education and Health Leaders:

According to the <u>U.S. Surgeon General</u>, vaping among youth of all ages is at epidemic proportions. Across New York State, the <u>prevalence of vaping among high school youth</u> is 18.7 percent. The New York State Department of Health and the New York State Education Department have teamed up to provide free "**DropTheVape**" materials aimed at helping middle schoolers and high schoolers quit vaping through a free text support service.

The New York State Department of Health has developed posters, palm cards, and rack cards for middle schools and high schools/young adults. The free materials are available <u>here</u> to view and download and print. The color posters are 11 x 17 and can be easily printed on a local printer or at a local vendor. The free posters and cards can also be ordered from the New York State Department of Health distribution center <u>here</u>.
