General guidelines for the Culminating Project & Panel Presentation:

- 1. For the purpose of the NYSSB, classical language students are evaluated on their Interpretiu b. The interpersonal section used to evaluate the student's Interpersonal Speaking skills.
- c. The presentational section used to evaluate the student's Presentational Speaking skills in English during the presentation.
- 3. Students should be assessed by a panel of reviewers consisting of two or more adults who are qualified speakers of the language being assessed.

I can deliver cohesive presentations, present clear and accurate arguments with supporting evidence, and give complex and detailed narrations on a variety of complex, concrete, and abstract topics related to community interests and some specialized fields, and often deal with related issues hypothetically.
